Thank you for your thoughtful letter about the negative impact of the Financial Reform bill on manufactured housing. I'm very proud of the work I have done with the manufactured housing industry for years, and I was regretful to realize that we did have this problem. I do not think it is necessary to include manufactured housing as part of our effort to prevent abusive mortgages practices, and I am now working with my staff to see if we can find a way to make a change that would deal with the problem you correctly point out.
